More about the founder & principal faculty: Ruben Solis has been working to advance people's liberation movements for over 45 years. Ruben co-founded the Southwest Workers' Union in 1988 in San Antonio, and two decades later, SWU is one of the most significant examples of community labor organizing, racial justice work, and environmental justice organizing in the country. Ruben was part of the founding of SW Network for Environmental & Economic Justice 1992, a group national & regional alliances as well as the Colegio Jacinto Trevino in 1970, a Chican@ Freedom School in the Rio Grande valley. In 2005 founded Grassroots Global Justice Alliance and in 2010 transitioned out of SWU and in 2011, Ruben founded the University Sin Fronteras to respond to the critical need for advanced social movement study based in practice, history, and theory. Today UNSIF operates in four campuses: Atlanta, San Juan, San Antonio and Detroit.
